





Ann's way of working with glass had reached a limit. Ann felt she needed to leave the "glass idyll" behind and start over from the beginning.

A restless progress had started. Ann left for Cologne, at that time the center for contemporary art in Germany. To study and to go inside herself, to find out what art was doing for her and what she could do for the arts. A new restless process got started which was expressed in a series of large charcoal drawings and pastels.

The Cologne Suite involved studies around old masters. Besides Ann's studies at that time most of Ann's works were based on an immense inspiration of the dancer Pina Bausch.

The drawings were originally drawn on a 19 m long roll of watercolourpaper in Cologne in 1989.
